use of electrical equipment

All equipment has instructions clearly attached.

provisions

You are welcome to use the church's tea, coffee and squash supplies. However, please supply your own **milk** and please do not use any other food or drink which may have been left out in the fridges, on the counters or in the cupboards.

take it away

Please do not leave any food or drink in the fridges or anywhere else on the church premises. Instead, take it home with you, and please remove all refuse, replacing the bin-liners.

keep it clean

Please clean up after you, washing all crockery, cutlery, oven equipment and glassware and returning it to its proper place. Wipe down the worktops and sweep the floor. A brush and dustpan should be to hand in the kitchen. **Please leave the kitchen as you found it.**

warnings!

Due to serious allergies suffered by children in our congregation, we operate a nut-free kitchen. Please do not bring nuts into the church or prepare foods involving nuts.

Please ensure that you switch off both water boilers, both coffee machines and the dishwasher before leaving.
